- 2. The children have His likeness.
- 3. The children have an assurance that He will supply all our need (Phil. 4:19).
- 4. The children are heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ of His inheritance (Rom. 8:17).
- As intimate as our Father is, He remains our Father is ?in heaven.?
